Licensees providing attest services shall be independent pursuant to the standards applicable to the report issued.

~~(1) A firm shall not express an opinion on financial statements (as that term is defined in the Standards for Independence) of an enterprise or on the reliability of an assertion by one party for use by another (third) party unless the firm is active licensed and independent with respect to such enterprise or the party making the assertion. A licensed firm is also precluded from expressing such an opinion if the firm is aware that an individual in the firm is not independent and that individual is a covered certified public accountant or is otherwise required to be independent. A certified public accountant shall not express such an opinion unless the certified public accountant is independent with respect to such enterprise or the party making the assertion. A certified public accountant is also precluded from expressing such an opinion if he or she is aware that an individual in the firm is not independent and that individual is a covered certified public accountant or is otherwise required to be independent. All covered certified public accountants and all other individuals who are required to be independent are required to disclose to the firm that they are~~

~~not independent prior to the issuance of such an opinion; failure to do so is a violation of this rule. All firms are required to adopt appropriate policies to implement the disclosure requirement and to monitor compliance therewith.~~
