Additionally, subsection 18-1.006(1) will be revised to remove reference to USPAP. Finally, subparagraphs 18-1.007(1)(b)4., 5., (5), (5)(a), and (6) F.A.C., will remove reference to USPAP and add reference to the Supplemental Standards for the Board of Trustees, as USPAP is a standard included within the Supplemental Standards Board of Trustees Appraisers are required to follow.

SUBJECT AREA TO BE ADDRESSED: The Rule amendments will provide appraisal procedures for state land acquisition.
