Project breakdown description

- South Central Utility Plant - South Campus Chiller Plant - A plan has been developed to add a new Central Utility Plant for the expanding southern portion of the FAMU campus. It would be located east of the current Multi-Purpose Recreation Center, housed in a metal building and initially include an 1100-Ton chiller, hot-water boilers, pumps, piping and electrical systems. With the later addition of piping, isolation valves and new underground distribution systems, a separate, South Campus-dedicated chilled water and hot water delivery system could be accomplished, initially serving the existing Recreation Center, and later a portion of the new Residence Hall initiatives after new underground piping and valves are added.

- This third-year Infrastructure improvement would extend the underground chilled water lines from the new South Chiller Plant to the “under-construction” Phase 2 700 Bed Residences and tie into those “under-construction” chilled water lines, providing chilled water to the Phase 2 residence buildings. FINAL ORDER
APPROVING ISLAMORADA, VILLAGE OF ISLANDS
ORDINANCE NO. 23-01

The Department of Economic Opportunity (“Department”) hereby issues its Final Order, pursuant to Section 380.05(6), Florida Statutes, approving land development regulations adopted by the Islamorada, Village of Islands, Florida (“Village”), by Ordinance No. 23-01 (the “Ordinance”).

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The Florida Keys Area is designated by Section 380.0552, Florida Statutes, as an area of critical state concern. The Village is a local government within the Florida Keys Area.

2. The Ordinance was adopted by the Village on January 19, 2023 and rendered to the Department on February 2, 2023.

3. The Ordinance amends Chapter 6, Article II, by creating Division 3, Building Code Administrative Amendments, which updates the minimum plan review criteria for commercial and residential buildings to include the declaration of land restriction (non-conversion agreements). The Ordinance also amends Chapter 6, Article II, by creating Division 4, Building Code Technical Amendments, which updates foundation design and construction requirements and enclosed area requirements for buildings located in coastal high-hazard areas and Coastal A Zones.

4. The Ordinance repeals and adopts a new Chapter 6, Article III, Floodplain Management Standards, to adopt flood hazard maps, to designate a floodplain administrator, and to adopt procedures and criteria for development in flood hazard areas.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

5. The Department is required to approve or reject land development regulations that are adopted by any local government in an area of critical state concern. *See* Section 380.05(6), Florida Statutes.

6. “Land development regulations” include local zoning, subdivision, building, and other regulations controlling the development of land. Section 380.031(8), Florida Statutes. The regulations adopted by the Ordinance are land development regulations.

7. The Ordinance is consistent with the Village’s Comprehensive Plan generally, as required by Section 163.3177(1), Florida Statutes, and is specifically consistent with Objective 5-1.17, Policy 5-1.17.2, Policy 5-1.17.3, Policy 5-2.2.1, Objective 5-2.3, Objective 5-2.4, and Policy 5-2.4.1.

8. All land development regulations enacted, amended, or rescinded within an area of critical state concern must be consistent with the principles for guiding development for that area. *See* Section 380.05(6), Florida Statutes. The Principles for Guiding Development for the Village are set forth in Section 380.0552(7), Florida Statutes.

9. The Ordinance is consistent with the Principles for Guiding Development for the Village as a whole, and specifically furthers the following Principles:

(a) Strengthening local government capabilities for managing land use and development so that local government is able to achieve these objectives without continuing the area of critical state concern designation.

(e) Limiting the adverse impacts of development on the quality of water throughout the Florida Keys.

(n) Protecting the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Florida Keys and maintaining the Florida Keys as a unique Florida resource.

WHEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Department finds that Ordinance No. 23-01 is consistent with the Village’s Comprehensive Plan and the Principles for Guiding Development for the Village and is hereby APPROVED.

This Final Order becomes final 21 days after publication in the Florida Administrative Register unless a petition is timely filed as described in the Notice of Administrative Rights below.
