The South Florida Water Management District (District) hereby gives notice: on September 12, 2013, the District's Governing Board issued SFWMD Order No. 2014-002-DAO-ROW to Craig Ehrnst on behalf of Peninsula corporate center Association (Application No. 13-1030-1). The petition for waiver was received by the District on November 6, 2013. Notice of receipt of the petition requesting the waiver was published in the Florida Administrative Register, Vol. 39, No. 219, on November 8, 2013. No public comment was received. This Order provides a waiver of the District's criteria to allow an existing culvert connection to remain within the south right of way of the C-15 Canal; Section 31, Township 46 South, Range 43 East; Palm Beach County. Specifically, the Order grants a waiver from subsection 40E-6.221(3)(j), Fla. Admin. Code, and the Basis of Review for Use or Occupancy of the Works or Lands of the District, incorporated by reference in

subsection 40E-6.091(1), Fla. Admin. Code, which governs the invert elevation of a culvert connection within works or lands of the District. Generally, the Order sets forth the basis of the Governing Board decision to grant the waiver as follows: 1) the existing culvert connection will not interfere with the District's current ability to perform necessary construction, alteration, operation, and routine maintenance activities; and 2) the Order granting a waiver from the subject rule is based upon a substantial hardship.
