PURPOSE AND EFFECT: The Department intends to amend Rule 65-29.001, F.A.C., to correct an internal inconsistency within the rule.

SUMMARY: All contracts entered into by the department for services shall contain a notice that penalties shall be imposed for failure to implement or to make acceptable progress on corrective action plans developed as a result of noncompliance, non-performance, or unacceptable performance with the terms and conditions of a contract.

SUMMARY OF STATEMENT OF ESTIMATED REGULATORY COSTS AND LEGISLATIVE RATIFICATION:

The Agency has determined that this will not have an adverse impact on small business or likely increase directly or indirectly regulatory costs in excess of \$200,000 in the aggregate within one year after the implementation of the rule. A SERC has not been prepared by the Agency.

The Agency has determined that the proposed rule is not expected to require legislative ratification based on the statement of estimated regulatory costs or if no SERC is required, the information expressly relied upon and described herein: The Department used a checklist to conduct an economic analysis and determine if there is an adverse impact or regulatory costs associated with this rule that exceeds the criteria in section 120.541(2)(a), F.S. Based upon this analysis, the Department has determined that the proposed rule is not expected to require legislative ratification.
