61C-1.004 General Sanitation and Safety Requirements

The Florida Department of Business and Professional Regulation, Division of Hotels and Restaurants hereby gives notice: On February 15, 2023 the Division of Hotels and Restaurants received a Petition for an Emergency Variance for paragraph 61C-1.004(1)(a), Florida Administrative Code and Paragraph 5-202.11(A), 2017 FDA Food Code from SCG Hotel LLC located in St. Petersburg. The above referenced F.A.C. addresses the requirement that each establishment have an approved plumbing system installed to transport potable water and wastewater. They are requesting to utilize holding tanks to provide potable water and to collect wastewater at the handwash and 3-compartment sinks.

The Petition for this variance was published in Vol. 49/32 on February 16, 2023. The Order for this Petition was signed and approved on February 23, 2023. After a complete review of the variance request, the Division finds that the application of this Rule will create a financial hardship to the food service establishment. Furthermore, the Division finds that the Petitioner meets the burden of demonstrating that the underlying statute has been achieved by the Petitioner ensuring the wastewater holding tank for the handwash sink is emptied at a frequency as to not create a sanitary nuisance; and potable water provided must come from an approved source and be protected from contamination during handling. The Petitioner shall also ensure that the handwash sinks are provided with hot and cold running water under pressure, soap, an approved hand drying device and a handwashing sign.

The Board considered the instant Petition at a duly-noticed public meeting held on January 26 and 27, 2023 in Tampa, Florida. The Board’s Order, filed on February 16, 2023, partially denying the petition finding that Petitioner had not shown that Manual Lymph Drainage for Intact Lymphatic System course is relevant to and focused on massage therapy techniques, skills, and protocols, as required by paragraph 64B7-28.009(4)(e), F.A.C. The Board partially granted the Petition finding the course Gua Sha-Tools for the Therapist-Sports Massage is approved for 8 credits toward in-person continuing education for paragraph 64B7-28.010(3)(a)(e), F.A.C.
