In addition, some language is being amended to provide more clarity, while using succinct language, regarding restroom cleanliness and access standards. SUMMARY: These rules address the general standards for operation and maintenance, special requirements and fixture ratios for temporary events and housing, restroom cleanliness, and sanitary supplies. The provisions of Rules 64E-10.003 and .004, F.A.C. are being combined and added to Rule 64E-10.001, F.A.C.

SUMMARY OF STATEMENT OF ESTIMATED REGULATORY COSTS AND LEGISLATIVE RATIFICATION: The Agency has determined that this will not have an adverse impact on small business or likely increase directly or indirectly regulatory costs in excess of \$200,000 in the aggregate within one year after the implementation of the rule. CHAPTER 64E-10, SANITARY <u>PRACTICES FOR</u>
<u>TOILETS AND WASHROOMS IN</u> <u>FACILITIES FOR</u>

PLACES OF EMPLOYMENT

Substantial rewording of Rule 64E-10.001 follows. See Florida Administrative Code for present text.

64E-10.001 General.

- (1) Toilets and washrooms shall be accessible to the public and employees, when the public place or place of employment is open and operating.
- (2) The following sanitary practices shall be used for the operation and maintenance of toilets and washrooms in public places and places of employment:
- (a) Floors and plumbing fixtures shall be cleaned and disinfected as needed, but no less than once a day;
- (b) Plumbing fixtures and plumbing shall be maintained in good working order and free from chips, cracks, leaks, waste back-up, or seepage;
- (c) Toilets and washrooms shall be furnished with soap, preferably liquid type, and single-use towels with a waste receptacle or a towel free automatic hand-drying device. The use of a common towel is prohibited; and
- (d) Each toilet shall be provided with toilet tissue and dispenser.
- (3) For the purpose of this rule, the term "disinfected" means the application of a product registered with the United States Environmental Protection Agency as a tuberculocidal disinfectant used in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.

64E-10.002 Special Requirements.

(1) For temporary outdoor events such as outdoor theaters and biker's week that are not covered by Department regulations, the 1994 Standard Plumbing Code and its 1995 Revisions, or the 1994 Standard Building Code, the Department shall use the following sanitary fixture ratios for public assembly:

SEE PUBLISHED PROPOSED RULE FOR TABLE.

For outdoor events over 2700 males, add 1 toilet, 1 urinal, and 1 handwashing sink for each additional 350 males. For more than 2700 females, add 1 toilet for each 350 people and 1 handwashing sink for each 500 attendees.

(2) Temporary Housing Facilities

Wherever temporary housing is provided to more than 60 people who are homeless as a result of displacement from their homes either by immigration, natural disaster, or financial hardship, the temporary housing facility shall provide a minimum of 1 toilet, 1 handwashing sink, and 1 shower for each 20 people or fraction thereof.
