- (1) In the 24 months preceding each biennial renewal period, every athletic trainer licensed pursuant to Chapter 468, Part XIII, F.S., shall be required to complete 24 hours of continuing education in courses approved by the Board. However, athletic trainers who receive an initial license during the second half of the biennium shall be required to complete only 12 hours of continuing education in courses approved by the Board prior to renewal. The hours of continuing education required for renewal must include a minimum of a two-hour course in prevention of medical errors required by Section 456.013(7), F.S. The continuing education requirement includes current certification in both cardiopulmonary cardiovascular pulmonary resuscitation with and the use of an automated external defibulator at the professional rescue level from the American Red Cross, the American Heart Association, American Safety and Health Institute, the National Safety Council, or an entity approved by the Board as equivalent. Athletic trainers who receive an initial license during the 90 days preceding a renewal period shall not be required to complete any continuing education for that renewal period.

- (3) Acceptable continuing education must focus on the domains of athletic training, including <u>Injury/Illness Prevention</u> and Wellness Protection, Clinical Evaluation and Diagnosis, <u>Immediate and Emergency Care</u>, Treatment and Rehabilitation,

and Organizational and Professional Health and Well-being prevention of athletic injuries; recognition, evaluation, and immediate care of athletic injuries; rehabilitation and reconditioning of athletic injuries; health care administration; or professional development and responsibility of athletic trainers.
