#### 53ER16-5 Cash Multiplier Second Chance Promotion.

- (1) Beginning January 12, 2016, through April 5, 2016, the Florida Lottery will conduct the Cash Multiplier Second Chance Promotion ("Promotion") in which players can enter non-winning Florida Lottery Scratch-Off tickets from the following FLAMINGO MULTIPLIER games into a second chance drawing for a chance to win a cash prize:
- (a) \$10,000 FLAMINGO MULTIPLIER Game Number 1296;
- (b) \$50,000 FLAMINGO MULTIPLIER Game Number 1297;

- (c) \$500,000 FLAMINGO MULTIPLIER Game Number 1298;
- (d) \$2,000,000 FLAMINGO MULTIPLIER Game Number 1299; and
- (e) \$5,000,000 FLAMINGO MULTIPLIER Game Number 1288.
