- (3) Students <u>failing</u> who fail the Commission-prescribed end-of-course examination <u>may retest a maximum of one time</u> within must wait at least 30 days from the date of the original examination to retest. Within one year of the original examination, a student may retest a maximum of one time. Otherwise, students who failing fail the <u>Commission-prescribed</u> end-of-course examination must repeat the course prior to being again to become eligible to again take the end-of-course examination. Schools shall administer a different form of the end-of-course examination to a student who is retaking retakes the exam or repeating repeats the course.
