PURPOSE AND EFFECT: The Board propose the rule amendment to update the text to reflect the legislative changes to the requirements for colon hydrotherapy training programs.

SUMMARY: To update the rule language due to legislative changes.

SUMMARY OF STATEMENT OF ESTIMATED REGULATORY COSTS AND LEGISLATIVE RATIFICATION:

The Agency has determined that this will not have an adverse impact on small business or likely increase directly or indirectly regulatory costs in excess of \$200,000 in the aggregate within

one year after the implementation of the rule. A SERC has not been prepared by the Agency.

The Agency has determined that the proposed rule is not expected to require legislative ratification based on the statement of estimated regulatory costs or if no SERC is required, the information expressly relied upon and described herein: During discussion of the economic impact of this rule at its Board meeting, the Board concluded that this rule change will not have any impact on licensees and their businesses or the businesses that employ them. The rule will not increase any fees, business costs, personnel costs, will not decrease profit opportunities, and will not require any specialized knowledge to comply. This change will not increase any direct or indirect regulatory costs. Hence, the Board determined that a Statement of Estimated Regulatory Costs (SERC) was not necessary and that the rule will not require ratification by the Legislature. No person or interested party submitted additional information regarding the economic impact at that time.

Any person who wishes to provide information regarding a statement of estimated regulatory costs, or provide a proposal for a lower cost regulatory alternative must do so in writing within 21 days of this notice.

#### NOTICE OF CHANGE

Notice is hereby given that the following changes have been made to the proposed rule in accordance with subparagraph 120.54(3)(d)1., F.S., published in Vol. 46 No. 123, June 24, 2020 issue of the Florida Administrative Register.

During a public hearing on Friday, July 24, 2020, the Commission on Ethics voted to approve the noticed changes to the financial disclosure forms incorporated by reference in these rules, as well as one additional change not previously

noticed. This additional change emphasizes that, when completing their financial disclosures forms, filers do not have to use the appraised value of their real property if a more accurate valuation is available.

In particular, the instructions for Part B of the Form 6, Form 6X, and Form 6F currently read, "Real property may be valued at its market value for tax purposes, unless a more accurate appraisal of its fair market value is available." This language is being changed to read, "Real property may be valued at its market value for tax purposes, unless a more accurate fair market value is available."

In addition, the instructions for Part C of the Form 1, Form 1X, and Form 1F currently read, "The value of the property may be determined by the most recently assessed value for tax purposes, in the absence of a more current appraisal." This language is being changed to read, "The value of the property may be determined by the most recently assessed value for tax purposes, in the absence of a more accurate fair market value."

EMERGENCY ORDER 20-034

WHEREAS, Novel Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) is a severe acute respiratory illness that can spread among humans through respiratory transmission and presents with symptoms similar to those of influenza; and

WHEREAS, as of March 15, 2020, numerous counties in Florida have positive cases for COVID-19, and COVID-19 poses a risk to the entire state of Florida; and

WHEREAS, the Governor issued Executive Order 20-52 on March 9, 2020, pursuant to the authority vested in him by Article IV, Section 1(a) of the Florida Constitution, the State Emergency Management Act, section 252.31, Florida Statutes, et al., as amended, and all other applicable laws, and declared a state of emergency for the State of Florida; and

WHEREAS, the Governor, in Executive Order Number 20-52, authorized each State agency to suspend the provisions of any regulatory statute of that agency, if strict compliance with that statute would in any way prevent, hinder, or delay necessary action in coping with this emergency; and

WHEREAS, on March 20, 2020, I executed Emergency Order 20-011, on March 26, 2020, I executed Emergency Order 20-014, and on March 31, 2020, I executed Emergency Order 20-016, all of which suspend certain provisions of regulatory statutes that may prevent, hinder, or delay necessary actions to assist Florida's Reemployment Assistance Program; and

WHEREAS, on May 1, 2020, I executed Emergency Order 20-019 which modified and extended Emergency Order 20-011 through May 9, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on May 8, 2020, I executed Emergency Order 20-020 which extended Emergency Orders 20-019, 20-014, and 20-016 through May 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on May 29, 2020, I executed Emergency Order 20-024 which extended, until June 13, 2020, the suspensions related to the online work registration requirement of section 443.091(1)(b), Florida Statutes, and the "actively seeking work" requirement of section 443.091(1)(d), Florida Statutes; and which extended, until August 1, 2020, the suspensions related to the license requirement for Appeals Referees in section 443.151(4)(a)2., Florida Statutes, the requirements of section 287.057, Florida Statutes, related to purchases, and the waiting week requirement of section 443.091(1)(f), Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, on June 11, 2020, I executed Emergency Order 20-026 which extended, until July 4, 2020, the suspensions related to the online work registration requirement of section 443.091(1)(b), Florida Statutes, and the "actively seeking work" requirement of section 443.091(1)(d), Florida Statutes.

WHEREAS, on July 1, 2020, I executed Emergency Order 20-028 which extended, until August 1, 2020, the suspensions related to the online work registration requirement of section 443.091(1)(b), Florida Statutes, and the "actively seeking work" requirement of section 443.091(1)(d), Florida Statutes.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, KEN LAWSON, Executive Director of Florida's Department of Economic Opportunity, pursuant to the authority granted by Executive Order No. 20-52, and in consultation with Secretary Jonathan Satter of the Department of Management Services, find the timely execution of the mitigation, response, and recovery aspects of the State's emergency management plan, as it relates to COVID-19, is

negatively impacted by the application of certain regulatory statutes related to the Department of Economic Opportunity ("the Department").

Therefore, I order the following:

1. The online work registration requirement in section 443.091(1)(b), Florida Statutes, is hereby suspended. This paragraph modifies the Department's Emergency Order 20-028 and shall remain in effect through September 5, 2020.

2. The "actively seeking work" requirement in section 443.091(1)(d), Florida Statutes, is hereby suspended consistent with the "emergency flexibility" provision of Families First Coronavirus Response Act, Division D Emergency Unemployment Insurance Stabilization and Access Act of 2020, Public Law 116-127, section 4102(b) and the Department of Labor's related guidance set forth in Unemployment Insurance Program Letter No. 13-20. This paragraph modifies the Department's Emergency Order 20-028 and shall remain in effect through September 5, 2020.

3. The requirement in section 443.151(4)(a)2., Florida Statutes, providing that each Appeals Referee appointed by the Department be an attorney in good standing with The Florida Bar or be successfully admitted to The Florida Bar within eight months of employment is hereby suspended. This paragraph modifies the Department's Emergency Order 20-024 and shall remain in effect through September 5, 2020.

4. Strict compliance with the requirements of section 287.057, Florida Statutes, would prevent, hinder, or delay necessary action in coping with the emergency; therefore, the requirements of section 287.057, Florida Statutes, applicable to the Department for purposes of making purchases necessary to address the increase in reemployment assistance claims, are suspended. This paragraph modifies the Department's Emergency Order 20-024 and shall remain in effect through September 5, 2020.

5. Strict compliance with the requirements of section 443.091(1)(f), Florida Statutes, would prevent, hinder, or delay necessary action in coping with the emergency; therefore, the requirements of section 443.091(1)(f), Florida Statutes, are suspended. This suspension shall apply retroactively for Reemployment Assistance claims filed the week beginning March 29, 2020. This paragraph modifies the Department's Emergency Order 20-024 and shall remain in effect through September 5, 2020.

6. Nothing herein shall be construed to effect or implicate any other requirements under federal law.
