FLORIDA HOUSING FINANCE CORPORATION

RULE NO.: RULE TITLE:
67ER20-1 Rent Increases

SPECIFIC REASONS FOR FINDING AN IMMEDIATE DANGER TO THE PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY OR WELFARE: As a result of the economic impacts of the Covid-19 pandemic many low-income residents of Florida are facing unprecedented financial difficulties in meeting their rent obligations. Florida Housing Finance Corporation finds that any rent increases during this Public Health Emergency would create an immediate danger to the public welfare and that creating incentives for owners of properties financed by the Corporation to suspend any rent increases during the emergency would help to alleviate this danger. Florida Housing also finds that it is necessary for the rule to become effective immediately on filing because of the immediate danger to the public welfare.

REASON FOR CONCLUDING THAT THE PROCEDURE IS FAIR UNDER THE CIRCUMSTANCES: This emergency rule will put developers on notice that implementing any rent increases during the Public Health Emergency could impact their ability to receive funding from the Corporation in the future.

SUMMARY: This rule provides that owners or developers of affordable housing that suspend any rent increases during the Public Health Emergency will receive preferences in future funding solicitations issued by the Corporation.

THE FULL TEXT OF THE EMERGENCY RULE IS:

67ER20-1 Rent Increases

(1) Purpose. The purpose of this emergency rule is to incentivize owners and developers of affordable housing to suspend rent increases during the Public Health Emergency declared by the Governor in Executive Order 20-52 and the Major Disaster Declaration for the State of Florida declared by the President (DR-4486).

(2) Duration of this Rule. This rule shall no longer be effective upon the earlier to occur of:

(a) The timeframe described in section 120.54(4)(c), F.S.;

(b) The expiration of both the Governor’s Executive Order 20-52 and the President’s Major Disaster Declaration for the State of Florida; or

(c) The date a final rule, if any, has been adopted pursuant to section 120.54, F.S., concerning the same subject matter herein.

(3) Definitions. The terms used in this emergency rule have the meaning found in Section 67-48.002, F.A.C.

(4) Any Applicant that can demonstrate that it, or an affiliated entity, suspended all increases in rent that impact existing tenants in housing financed in whole or in part by the Corporation while either the Governor’s Executive Order or the President’s Major Disaster Declaration is in effect will be entitled to a preference in Requests for Applications issued by the Corporation for one year after the effective date of this emergency rule. The specifics of any such preferences will be provided in the individual solicitations.

The Florida Department of Business and Professional Regulation, Division of Hotels and Restaurants hereby gives notice: On April 1, 2020 the Division of Hotels and Restaurants received a Petition for a Routine Variance for paragraph 61C-1.004(1)(a), Florida Administrative Code and Paragraph 5-202.11(A), 2017 FDA Food Code from FALMAR INVESTMENTS LLC located in ORLANDO. The above referenced F.A.C. addresses the requirement that each establishment have an approved plumbing system installed to transport potable water and wastewater. They are requesting to utilize holding tanks to provide potable water and to collect wastewater at the handwash and 3-compartment sinks.

The Petition for this variance was published in Vol. 46/66 on April 3, 2020. The Order for this Petition was signed and approved on April 29, 2020. After a complete review of the variance request, the Division finds that the application of this Rule will create a financial hardship to the food service establishment. Furthermore, the Division finds that the Petitioner meets the burden of demonstrating that the underlying statute has been achieved by the Petitioner ensuring the wastewater holding tank for the handwash sinks and 3-compartment sink are emptied at a frequency as to not create a sanitary nuisance; and potable water provided must come from an approved source and be protected from contamination during handling. The Petitioner shall also ensure that the handwash sinks are provided with hot and cold running water under pressure, soap, an approved hand drying device and a handwashing sign.
