(10) All requisite experience shall be verified by attestation, describing in detail each separate period of work experience listed in the application form, signed by a licensed architect, engineer, contractor, fire marshal, or building code administrator who has knowledge of the applicant’s duties and responsibilities during the period indicated. The form that shall be used for this purpose shall be form DBPR BCAIB 1, Application for Initial Certification by Examination or Endorsement – Inspectors and Plans Examiners, effective May 2021, incorporated in DBPR Rule 61-35.008, F.A.C., copies of which may be obtained from the Board office, provided by the Department and available on the Department’s website. 69J-123.003 Property Insurance Intent to Initiate Litigation Notice

PURPOSE AND EFFECT: The rulemaking implements section 627.70152, Florida Statutes, which requires claimants under a residential or commercial property insurance policy to provide pre-suit notice of intent to initiate litigation to the insurer. The statute requires the Department of Financial Services to accept the notice and provide it to the appropriate insurer.

SUMMARY: The rule creates a form for claimants to provide statutory notice to insurers of the claimant’s intent to file a claim prior to initiating a lawsuit.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on October 19, 2022, the Department of Environmental Protection, received a petition for variance from Chemours Company, FC LLC. The Petitioner owns and operated the Florida Mine - Trail Ridge Facility, which is located at 5222 Treat Road, Starke, Florida 32091, Bradford County. The Petitioner has applied for and obtained a wastewater permit renewal under the National Pollution Discharge Elimination System (NPDES). The Trail Ridge Facility does not meet the limit for total recoverable iron, within Specific Condition Number I.A. I of the NPDES permit. The petition requests a variance from subsection 62-302.530(38), F.A.C., which sets a surface water quality standard for iron to be equal to or less than 1.0 milligrams per liter. Project Description: Central Polk Parkway (SR 570B) from US 17 (SR 35) to SR 60

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) Florida's Turnpike Enterprise (FTE) will hold a Design Public Information Meeting for the Central Polk Parkway (SR 570B) project to from US 17 (SR 35) to SR 60. This meeting will give interested persons an opportunity to review the project design and ask questions about the proposed improvements.

The proposed improvements are designed to accommodate traffic capacity on the Central Polk Parkway and interchanges to meet anticipated traffic demand. These improvements include a new four-lane, limited access toll road with an interchange at US 17, an intersection at SR 60, and a multiuse trail adjacent to the new roadway. This extension of the Central

Polk Parkway will connect to the section of the Central Polk Parkway project to the north scheduled to begin construction in early 2023, providing a direct connection to I-4 via the Polk Parkway (SR 570). This will reduce travel times to Tampa and Orlando, improve freight movements, and relieve congestion on SR 60 and US 98. The proposed multiuse trail will provide a scenic path overlooking native Florida landscapes that will ultimately connect to the regional trail network.
