**Notice of Entry of Amended Final Order for the Statewide Alternative Method Approval for Reagent-less In-line Chlorine Meters**

The Department of Environmental Protection, Division of Environmental Assessment and Restoration, gives notice that, pursuant to Rule 62-160.220, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), an amended final order was entered on March 9, 2022, approving as a statewide alternative method the use of reagent-less amperometric meters for continuous in-line residual chlorine measurements to comply with continuous monitoring requirements for reclaimed water in Rule 62-600.660 and Chapter 62-610, F.A.C., at domestic wastewater facilities. The scope of approval does not include cases where the reclaimed water is directly discharged to surface waters of the state or is intentionally used as a drinking water supply or to augment a drinking water supply.
