In order to demonstrate compliance with continuing education requirements, licensees must affirmatively declare completion of the continuing education requirements upon licensure renewal. Said declaration shall be accomplished by establishment of a free National Council of Examiners for Engineering and Surveying (NCEES) Continuing Professional Competency ("CPC") Tracking Account and certification by the Licensee of the holding of such account.
- (a) Licensees shall be responsible for uploading CE credits to the NCEES Tracking Account.

- (b) At the time of licensure renewal, each licensee shall indicate on the renewal application that such account has been established.
- (c) Upon so certifying, the Licensee shall be allowed to proceed with renewal of the license.
