1. No, Chapter 489, F.S., does not require that a state-licensed sheet metal contractor subcontract the installation of a steel roof curb, when the sheet metal contractor installs a hood exhaust system.

Work Order No. 863096, Center Drive Utilities Corridor (Chilled Water, Steam, and Electric)

The Project consists of the installation of 3,000 LF of 18" chilled water mains, 650 LF of steam and condensate mains, and 1,500 LF of electrical duct bank work in the Center Drive area of the University, along with site restoration and temporary measures as needed to allow safe, continuous access by vehicles, bicycles, and pedestrians. The work shall commence in June 2006 and be Substantially Completed by January 2007. The Contractor must coordinate the scheduling and execution of the Work with work being accomplished by others in certain adjacent areas and with daily operations of the multiple roads and facilities that will be impacted by the Work.
