the state plan and would otherwise be receiving institutional level care based on an approved application for such care but for the application of the penalty period meets all other factors of eligibility (including appropriate placement in a Medicaid nursing facility, enrollment in a Medicaid waiver or election of Hospice care) except for the transfer of assets without fair compensation after applying for institutional care services; or (2) the first day of the month in which the individual transfers the asset; or (3) the first day following the end of an existing penalty period. The department shall not round down, or otherwise disregard, any fractional period of ineligibility of the penalty period but will calculate the period down to the day. There is no limit on the period of ineligibility. Once the penalty period is imposed, it will continue although the individual may no longer meet all factors of eligibility and may no longer qualify for Medicaid long-term care benefits.

(b) An individual's entrance fee in a continuing care retirement community or life care community shall be considered a resource, <u>as set forth in 1917(g) of the Social</u> <u>Security Act</u>, which is incorporated herein by reference available to the individual to the extent that after (effective date), regardless of whether a refund is actually received, if the individual has the ability to use the entrance fee or the contract indicates the entrance fee may be used for care when the individual's income and assets are insufficient to pay for their care; the individual is eligible for a refund of any remaining entrance fee upon death or termination of the contract; and the entrance fee does not confer an ownership interest in the retirement community.

The Petitioner shall strictly adhere to subsection 61C-4.0161(c), Florida Administrative Code, and report to the commissary at least once daily when operating. All warewashing is to be conducted at the commissary and strict adherence to employee health guidelines as specified in the Section 2-201, 2001 FDA Food Code, are to be followed. Petitioner shall also use a potable water tank and utilize a wastewater holding tank that is at least 15% larger than the potable water holding tank; and sloped to a drain that is 1 inch in inner diameter or greater, equipped with a shut-off valve. Petitioner must receive potable water from an approved source with written documentation provided and sanitize the fresh water and wastewater tanks at least once every 24 hours.
