(1) Name of Game. Instant Game Number 715, "MONEY MONEY MONEY."

(2) Price. MONEY MONEY MONEY lottery tickets sell for \$5.00 per ticket.

(3) MONEY MONEY MONEY lottery tickets shall have a series of numbers in machine readable code (or bar code) on the back of the ticket, along with a validation number under the latex area on the ticket. To be a valid winning MONEY MONEY MONEY lottery ticket, the ticket must meet the applicable requirements of Rule 53ER06-4, F.A.C.

To be a valid winning ON A ROLL lottery ticket, the ticket must meet the applicable requirements of Rule 53ER06-4, F.A.C.

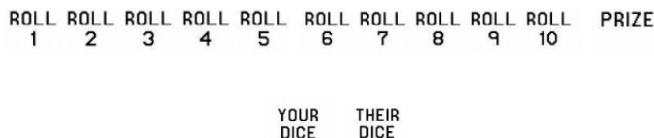

(8) Determination of Prizewinners.

(a) There are ten rolls on a ticket. A ticket having a play symbol and corresponding play symbol caption in the "YOUR DICE" play area that beats the play symbol and corresponding play symbol caption in the "THEIR DICE" play area shall entitle the claimant to the corresponding prize shown for that

roll. A ticket having a "CHIP" symbol in the "YOUR DICE" play area shall entitle the claimant to all 10 prizes.

(b) The prizes are: TICKET, \$1.00, \$2.00, \$5.00, \$10.00, \$20.00, \$25.00, \$50.00, \$100, \$1,000 and \$12,000.
