The petition asks eight complex questions, dealing with the interplay between Section 509.215, F.S., Chapter 663, F.S., and the rules comprising the Florida Fire Prevention Code, as they

relate to fire sprinkler systems in transient public lodging facilities. The Declaratory Statement concludes that Chapter 509, Florida Statutes, provides a time frame for compliance with the sprinkler requirements contained therein. By January 1, 1994, all licensed transient public lodging facilities were required to be fully sprinklered; thereafter, they were required to meet the requirements of the Florida Fire Prevention Code for new and existing facilities.
