**DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS AND PROFESSIONAL

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Department of Business and Professional Regulation, State of Florida has received the petition for declaratory statement from BK WHOPPER BAR, LLC, a Florida limited liability company and BURGER KING CORPORATION, a Florida corporation, Docket Number DS 2011-017. The petition seeks the agency's opinion as to the applicability of Sections 561.22 and 561.42(i), Florida Statutes as it applies to the petitioner.

Whether the fact that a minority of the Board of Directors of BKC, which constitutes an even smaller minority of the Board of Directors of AB InBev (including wholly owned subsidiaries) precludes licensure of BK Whopper Bar, LLC, as a vendor, pursuant to Section 561.22(1) & (3), Florida Statutes. Petitioner asserts that BK Whopper Bar is neither a manufacturer nor a distributor, or exporter, pursuant to Section 561.22(3), Florida Statutes, and would not be barred by Section 561.22(3), Florida Statutes from being a vendor. Moreover, Petitioner explains that BK Whopper Bar is not affiliated with AB InBev and there is no majority ownership or control of BK Whopper Bar by a corporation that owns a majority of or controls another corporation that is a manufacturer, distributor, or exporter of alcoholic beverages. Therefore, Petitioners request a Declaratory Statement that the above-referenced business structure is permissible under Chapter 561, Florida Statutes, and BK Whopper Bar, LLC, is permitted to hold a Florida Alcoholic Beverage License as a retail vendor.

The petition seeks the agency’s opinion as to the applicability of Section 849.086(13)(d)2., Florida Statutes, as it applies to the petitioner.

Specifically, the Petition requests the Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering to declare that under Section 849.086(13)(d)2., Florida Statutes, any supplement from Calder’s cardroom operations to purses and breeders’ awards is in the aggregate for Calder’s “next ensuing racing meeting” based on the aggregation of monthly net proceeds on a calendar year basis, and that Calder may therefore consider all monthly net proceeds for a year, both positive and negative, thus requiring Calder to supplement purses by fifty percent (50%) of such net proceeds only if the sum of the monthly net proceeds is a positive number. Any person whose substantial interests may be affected by a declaratory statement on the subject matter of the Petition may file a petition to intervene within 14 days of the publication of this notice.
