Project: UF-621, UF Veterinary Hospital and CVM Expansion Gainesville, FL

The facility will include the addition of +/- 15,000 GSF of office space on two floors in front of the existing building 215. There will also be renovation of 2400 SF of existing space in Building 215 together with the addition of a new IT room and a 3rd floor mechanical penthouse.
