61G20-1.001 Florida Building Code Adopted

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the Binding Interpretation Panel has issued a binding interpretation pursuant to Section 553.775, Florida Statutes, submitted by Hendrick Roofing, Inc., and accepted by BOAF on February 9, 2018. The following is a summary of the interpretation:

Issue (as stated by Petitioner): Section 104.9, FBC should be interpreted at the very least to mean that when, as here, a building official has approved the material based on required documents submitted by Petitioner but has denied local product approval based upon failure to submit an affidavit from the Engineer of Record stating that the approved materials have been installed pursuant to such approval, that Petitioner (and the Engineer of Record) has a right to conduct such an inspection prior to a denial by the building official and in accordance with the official's own instructions. Further, when the building official or his inspector has already inspected the installed material and such installation passed final inspection, the same material should receive final permit approval when the only amendment to the permit application after initially being passed was the name of the material manufacturer. The installation method for the metal roofing panels is identical, save for the name of the manufacturer. If the installation was adequate before a minor amendment regarding the manufacturer was made, it stands to reason the inspection results should remain the same after and the permit should be immediately reinstated and finalized without any further inspections being required.

Answer: The Building Official has the authority to deny local product approval due to the lack an installation instruction specification submittal from the design professional.

The Building Official has the authority to revoke a permit, as provided by FBC 105.6, that has been determined to be issued or has passed final inspection that is not in compliance with the Florida Building Code. [The permit in question was obtained and approved within one year of filing of this interpretation request.]

The Building Official can accept an inspection affidavit, as provided by FBC 105.14, from the design professional, if the Building Official deems the affidavit addresses the scope of the installation and code compliance issues in question with sufficient specificity.

In this particular situation, the design professional is allowed under the Florida Building Code to conduct a field inspection of the roof system.

FINAL ORDER

APPROVING MONROE COUNTY ORDINANCE NO. 022-2017

The Department of Economic Opportunity ("Department") hereby issues its Final Order, pursuant to sections 380.05(6) and 380.0552(9), Florida Statutes, approving land development regulations adopted by Monroe County, Florida, Ordinance No. 022-2017 (the "Ordinance").

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. The Florida Keys Area is designated by Section 380.0552, Florida Statutes, as an area of critical state concern. Monroe County is a local government within the Florida Keys Area.
- 2. The Ordinance was adopted by Monroe County on October 18, 2017, and rendered to the Department on January 25, 2018.
- 3. The Ordinance amends the Monroe County Land Development Code ("Code") to permit temporary emergency housing on residential and nonresidential parcels for Monroe County residents that have been displaced by natural or manmade disaster. The Ordinance amends the criteria that must be met for the placement of emergency housing and limits the placement of temporary emergency housing on vacant residential properties to travel trailers, RVs or similar sheltering units provided and licensed by FEMA.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

4. The Department is required to approve or reject land development regulations that are adopted by any local

government in an area of critical state concern. Sections 380.05(6), and 380.0552(9), Florida Statutes.

- 5. "Land development regulations" include local zoning, subdivision, building, and other regulations controlling the development of land. Section 380.031(8), Florida Statutes. The regulations adopted by the Ordinance are land development regulations.
- 6. The Ordinance is consistent with the Monroe County Comprehensive Plan generally, and specifically, Policy 101.3.7.
- 7. All land development regulations enacted, amended, or rescinded within an area of critical state concern must be consistent with the principles for guiding development for that area. Sections 380.05(6) and 380.0552(9), Florida Statutes. The Principles for Guiding Development for the Florida Keys Area of Critical State Concern are set forth in section 380.0552(7), Florida Statutes.
- 8. The Ordinance is consistent with the Principles for Guiding Development as a whole, and specifically complies with the following:
- (a) Strengthening local government capabilities for managing land use and development so that local government is able to achieve these objectives without continuing the area of critical state concern designation.
- (m) Providing adequate alternatives for the protection of public safety and welfare in the event of a natural or manmade disaster and for a postdisaster reconstruction plan.

WHEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the Department finds that Monroe County Ordinance No. 022-2017 is consistent with the Monroe County Comprehensive Plan and Principles for Guiding Development for the Florida Keys Area of Critical State Concern and is hereby APPROVED.

This Order becomes effective 21 days after publication in the Florida Administrative Register unless a petition is timely filed as described in the Notice of Administrative Rights below.
