Page 8, Section VII, “Prescription Drug Distribution Activity”: The rule text provides that this permit is required for a hospital or a health care entity as defined in s. 499.003(15), F.S., for the limited purpose of transferring prescription drugs among hospitals or other health care entities that are: (1) under “common control” as provided in Section 499.012(1)(a)3., F.S. or (2) members of a group purchasing organization as provided for in Section 499.012(1)(a)1., F.S. Transfers are limited to a facility under common control or a group purchasing organization, either of which must be licensed with a pharmacy permit that authorizes the acquisition and possession of prescription drugs.

The application form for a permit as a Restricted Prescription Drug Distributor-Health Care Entity is amended to delete all current options for intended customers and to replace that list with the following: (1) hospitals that have a pharmacy license and that are under common control as provided for in s. 499.012(1)(a)3., F.S., with the permitted entity; (2) health care entities that have a pharmacy permit and that are under common control as provided for in s. 499.012(1)(a)3., F.S., with the permitted entity; (3) hospitals that are members of a group purchasing organization as provided for in s.499.012(1)(a)1., F.S.; and (4) health care entities that are members of a group purchasing organization as provided for in s.499.012(1)(a)1., F.S.
