Project improvements include embankment repairs at SR 700 and the L-10 Canal, including bank stabilization and revetments, guardrail replacement, signing and pavement markings, and signalization replacement. Work will be done in three (3) phases with full closures expected during the summer months in 2021 and 2022.
