Other improvements include traffic safety, ADA upgrades, signing & pavement markings, lighting, signalization, and drainage improvements. The Bridge Project will provide bridge rehabilitation that will include structural repairment to the bridge, and mechanical and electrical work as well as a tender house parking area.

The same information will be presented at both the virtual and in-person Public Meeting, so attending both is not necessary. Both formats will consist of a formal presentation followed by a question-and-answer session. Staff will be available to answer questions and provide assistance.
