#### **64B3-12.001 Disciplinary Guidelines.**

(1) No Change.

(2) Violations and Range of Penalties. For applicants, all violations are sufficient for refusal to certify an application for licensure. For registrants or licensees, the imposition of probation as a penalty shall ordinarily require compliance with conditions such as restitution, continuing education and/or training, indirect or direct supervision by a Board-approved monitor, restrictions on practice, submission of reports, appearances before the Board, and/or hours of community service. As appropriate, such conditions of probation also shall be required following any period of suspension. In addition to any other discipline imposed, the Board shall assess the actual costs related to the investigation and prosecution of a case. In imposing discipline pursuant to Sections 120.57(1) and (2), F.S., the Board shall act in accordance with the following disciplinary guidelines and shall impose a penalty as authorized by Section 456.072(2), F.S., within the range corresponding to the violations set forth below. Offense identifications are descriptive only; the full language of each statutory provision must be considered in order to determine the conduct included.

**68D-15.002 Effective Means of Propulsion**

(1) No change.

(2) Evaluation procedures.

(a) Once a law enforcement officer has reason to believe a

vessel does not have an effective means of propulsion for safe navigation, and the vessel owner or operator is unable to provide a receipt, proof of purchase, or other documentation of having ordered necessary parts for repair, if the owner or operator is present on the vessel, a law enforcement officer may require a test of the vessel's effective means of propulsion for safe navigation, to be conducted immediately ~~the officer shall notify the owner by telephone, or in writing, which may be by email. If the owner or operator is not present on the vessel, the owner or operator must, in the presence of law enforcement, conduct the test for effective means of propulsion for safe navigation within 48 hours after the vessel owner or operator receives notice from a law enforcement officer~~ The officer shall provide a location and a date and time, no less than 72 hours later, when the owner or operator of the vessel shall meet the officer to either provide proof of having ordered the necessary parts for repair or to conduct an evaluation of the vessel as provided herein. Proof of having ordered parts for repair may be provided to the officer before the date and time of the scheduled evaluation. No person shall be required to complete an evaluation under paragraph (b) when such person has been notified by a law enforcement officer that the vessel does not have an effective means of propulsion for safe navigation and has, within 48 ~~72~~ hours of such notification, provided to the officer a receipt, proof of purchase, or other documentation of having ordered necessary parts for repairs to the vessel's propulsion or steering. When an owner or operator provides proof of having ordered the necessary parts for repair, he or she shall complete all necessary repairs to make the vessel's propulsion or steering functional within 30 days or shall remove the vessel from the waters of the state.
