ANTIFREEZE REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS July 1, ____ through June 30, ____

Section 501.913, Florida Statutes, requires the annual registration of each brand of antifreeze marketed in Florida. This must be done before the product is offered for sale and prior to July 1 of the registration year. The permit year extends from July 1 to June 30. To register, send a completed application form and a \$200 registration fee.

Please note the changes in the form regarding information about the applicant.

The \$200 registration fee as a check or money order payable to the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services (FDACS) is to be attached to the **original** application form and sent to:

In addition, a one gallon sample of the product, a product label and a **copy** of the original application are to be sent to:

Please refer to Section 501.913, Florida Statutes, and Rule Chapter 5J-23, F.A.C., for quality and branding specifications. Section 501.916(1)(b), Florida Statutes, provides guidance for the labeling of antifreeze products. A product is mislabeled if it does not bear a label that specifies the name and address of the manufacturer, packager or distributor. Please review all registration requirements to ensure that your product will be processed in a timely manner.

In accordance with Section 501.918, F.S., it is unlawful to distribute any antifreeze in Florida that has not been registered with the Department. The Department will issue and enforce stop sale orders for any antifreeze distributed in violation of Sections 501.91-501.923, F.S., and Rule Chapter 5J-23, F.A.C. The Department may also levy fines for violations of Chapter 501, Part V, Florida Statues, and/or Rule Chapter 5J-23, F.A.C., up to \$5,000, per violation. The registrant shall assume liability for compliance with the requirements referenced in Chapter 501, Part V, Florida Statues, and/or Rule Chapter 5J-23, F.A.C.
