1. This company has constructed or leases a bulk filling plant of not less than 18,000 gallons (water capacity) in Florida, which is located within a 75-mile radius of the licensed location.
2. This company was licensed as a category I LP Gas Dealer on August 31, 2000, and has a written agreement with a wholesaler to provide 18,000 gallons (water capacity) minimum LP gas storage to the dealer for a period of twelve (12) continuous months (only applies to companies licensed as of August 31, 2000-section below must be completed and signed by wholesaler).
3. This company operates a single dispensing unit for the sole purpose of direct sales to customers and does not deliver product.
4. This company is a cylinder exchange operator only.
