Qualifications for Temporary Certificate

- 1. Must be a military health care practitioner who is serving on active duty in the United States Armed Forces, the United States Reserve Forces, the National Guard, or is on active duty in the United States Armed Forces and serving in the United States Public Health Services.
- 2. Must submit proof that you are practicing pursuant to a military platform as defined in section (s.) 456.0241(1)(b), Florida Statutes (F.S.).
- 3. Must hold an active, unencumbered license as a military health care practitioner in a U.S. jurisdiction, or serve as a military health care practitioner in a profession for which licensure in a state or jurisdiction is not required to practice in the United States Armed Forces. If your active, unencumbered license is not verifiable online, we will request that you have the licensing entity send official license verification to the Department of Health. If you are a military health care practitioner in a profession for which licensure is not required, you must submit evidence of military training or experience substantially equivalent to the requirements for licensure in Florida and evidence that you have obtained a passing score on the appropriate examination for licensure in this state, if required by that profession.
- 4. Must attest that you are not the subject of a disciplinary proceeding in a jurisdiction in which you hold a license, or by the United States Department of Defense, for reasons related to the practice of the profession for which you are applying. Information will be verified by the Department of Health using the National Practitioner Data Bank.
- 5. Certain professions require Livescan screening, listed below. Fees are required for the background screening (paid directly to the Livescan vendor). This notice is to inform you that when you submit a set of fingerprints to the Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) for the purpose of conducting a search for any Florida and national criminal history records that may pertain to you, the results of that search will be returned to the Care Provider Background Screening Clearinghouse. By submitting fingerprints, you are authorizing the dissemination of any state and national criminal history record to be employed, licensed, work under contract, or serve as a volunteer, pursuant to the National Child Protection Act of 1993, as amended, and Section 943.0542, Florida Statutes. "Specified agency" means the Department of Health, the Department of Children and Family Services, the Division of Vocational Rehabilitation within the Department of Education, the Agency for Health Care Administration, the Department of Elder Affairs, the Department of Juvenile Justice, and the Agency for Person with Disabilities when these agencies are conducting state and national criminal history background screening on persons who provide care for children or persons who are elderly or disabled. The fingerprints submitted will be retained by FDLE and the Clearinghouse will be notified if FDLE receives Florida arrest information on you.

Your Social Security Number (SSN) is needed to keep records accurate because other people may have the same name and birth date. Disclosure of your SSN is imperative for the performance of the Clearinghouse agencies' duties in distinguishing your identity from that of other persons whose identification information may be the same or similar to yours.
