Facilities and caging must pass inspection and meet the standards set forth in Chapter 68-5, F.A.C., for possessing Conditional species.
Public exhibition of live Prohibited species
Facilities and caging must pass inspection and meet the standards set forth in Chapter 68-5, F.A.C., for possessing Prohibited species. Drainage plans for aquatic species enclosures must be included with application submission.
Limited exceptions are in place for exhibitors who possessed tegus or green iguanas prior to their listing as Prohibited species under a valid License to Possess Class III Wildlife for Exhibition or Public Sale (ESC) and do not otherwise meet the eligibility requirements for exhibition of Prohibited species. To qualify for a limited exception, applicants must have had a valid ESC on June 30, 2020 and either documented tegus and/or green iguanas in their inventory or documented that they planned to possess tegus or green iguanas on their 2018 or 2019 ESC license applications.

A completed <u>Critical Incident and Disaster Plan (FWCDLE 619 6/09)</u> Part A must be submitted with this application. Part B must be maintained at the location where the animals are housed and made available upon request from Commission personnel.

Section 4: Documentation of Educational Exhibition

Permits to possess Conditional and/or Prohibited species for exhibition use may only be issued to qualifying public exhibitors providing educational exhibits.

A public exhibitor is defined in Rule 68-5.002(9), F.A.C., as a permanent, fixed facility in which Conditional and/or Prohibited species are confined in such a manner that the general public is able to view them during regularly scheduled business hours, either through scheduled tours or general admission, with or without a fee.

An educational exhibit is defined in Rule 68-5.002(3), F.A.C., as an organized presentation or display of a nonnative fish or wildlife species along with a selection of educational materials to include interpretive signs, presentations, brochures, handouts, or other materials which impart knowledge about the displayed species. Such materials shall include information about the species' range, habitat, biology, and threats the species poses to Florida's ecology, economy, or human health and safety.
