An instructor student shall demonstrate all the required First Aid High-Liability Proficiency Skills at 100% with the results recorded on this form. No retest allowed.					
	• WRITTEN END-of-Course Examination: An instructor student shall achieve a minimum score of no less than 85% on the first aid written end-of-course examination. No retest is allowed.					
	An instructor student who fails either the demonstration of proficiency or the written end-of-course examination shall be deemed to have failed the First Aid Instructor Course.

INSTRUCTOR TO STUDENT RATIO: For instruction of the First Aid for Criminal Justice Officers Course or First Aid Instructor Course, at least one Commission certified First Aid Instructor shall be required for every ten students actively engaged in the practical and performance areas of the training. The lead CPR instructor's affiliated association shall set the CPR performance riteria and cognitive CPR examination. A basic recruit student who does not meet the designated association CPR standards shall not be permitted to take the end-of-course examination for the First Aid for Criminal Justice Officer Course.
