SHIPMENT OF REGULATED ARTICLES (FIREWOOD AND UNPROCESSED WOOD PRODUCTS) FROM THE STATE OF [NAME OF STATE] TO FLORIDA IN COMPLIANCE WITH RULE CHAPTER 5B-65-FIREWOOD AND UNPROCESSED WOOD PRODUCTS, FLORIDA ADMINISTRATIVE CODE.			
Permission is granted to the [name of state] Department of Agriculture to authorize firms to ship firewood or unprocessed wood products grown in [name of state] to Florida subject to the conditions of this permit.			
		CONDITIONS	
1.	Only firms that have signed a compliance agreement with the [name of state] Department of Agriculture will be authorized to ship firewood or unprocessed wood products under this permit. The compliance agreement shall specify all required treatments applied or measures taken prior to shipment to assure the product is free of Wood boring pests, Wood inhabiting pests, and Plant disease pathogens as defined in Chapter 5B-65, F.A.C.		
2.	The [name of state] Department of Agriculture shall provide annually to the Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, Division of Plant Industry (FDACS/DPI), a list of firms authorized to ship under this permit and the identification number of each firm.		
3.	All shipments of firewood or unprocessed wood products shall be accompanied by a certificate indicating compliance with Florida's Firewood and Unprocessed Wood Products rule, Chapter 5B-65, F.A.C.		
4.	Any shipment of firewood or unprocessed wood products found to be infected or infested with Wood boring pests, Wood inhabiting pests, or Plant disease pathogens as defined in Chapter 5B-65, F.A.C., shall be disposed of in accordance with 5B-65.005, F.A.C., and acceptance of further shipments of firewood or unprocessed wood products from the party in violation shall be suspended. The suspension shall remain in effect until the [name of state] Department of Agriculture has notified the FDACS/DPI in writing that the shipper is in compliance with all requirements for treatment of firewood or unprocessed wood products.
