b) Section II - Company Information

- i) Applicants must provide the Federal Employer Identification Number (FEID) for the business to be qualified.
- ii) Provide the name of the real estate company as it is registered with the Florida Division of Corporations.
- iii) The "Doing Business As" (D/B/A) name must be provided as it is registered with the Florida Division of Corporations, if the real estate company uses a fictitious name to conduct business.
