If you have questions concerning whether or not we have received items which we require you to arrange to be sent to this office by a third party (such as official transcripts, licensure verifications from state licensing agencies); please check with the third party first to see if the required documentation has been sent. As a reminder to all applicants, Chapter 456.013(1)(a), Florida Statutes, provides that an incomplete application shall expire one year after initial filing with the department.
