City populations are taken from the U.S. Census for 1990.

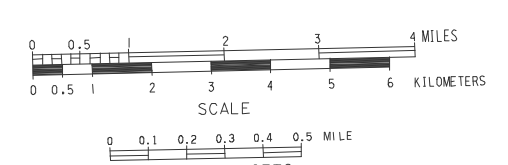
In 1990, the population of Okaloosa County was 127,761, based on 954 square miles of the county.
