

Charter School Applicant Training Standards Certification Form

Instructions: Sponsor must complete, sign, and submit this form prior to requiring charter school applicants to attend the sponsor's training.

The Department of Education has developed the following standards for charter school applicant training.

- Applicant training shall specifically address:
 - The Florida Statutes and State Board Rules governing charter schools
 - Sponsor, charter school, and governing board responsibilities
 - Sponsor duties and services available to the charter school
 - Developing and adjusting business plans
 - State and federal grant and student performance accountability reporting requirements
- Applicant training shall provide instruction in accurate financial planning and good business practice that includes:
 - A review of how charter schools are funded
 - Accounting for costs related to classroom instruction, instructional support services, governing board support services, school administration, facilities acquisition, fiscal services, plant operations, pupil transportation, and food services
 - A description of the government accounting model, internal controls, and separation of duties
 - A summary of charter school audit requirements
- Applicant training shall identify the types and amounts of state and federal financial assistance a charter school may be eligible to receive which shall include, at a minimum, a summary of the following:
 - The allocation of Title 1 and IDEA funding and services
 - Eligibility and requirements for capital outlay funds
 - The Federal Charter Schools Program Grant and eligibility requirements
 - The process for applying for state and federal financial assistance
