



FLUSAR Trench Rescue Operations and Technician: Equipment List

Effective May 1, 2016

1. Have a classroom with adequate lighting, heating, cooling and ventilation.
2. Have access to utilize the appropriate land area to construct trenches or appropriate trench props that allow for all course objectives to be met.
3. Have the equipment cache listed in Appendix C.
