Identifiers listed below may be used by those who comply with the law as provided by Chapter 571, Florida Statutes as follows:

- 1) The "Fresh From Florida" Identifier, is eligible for use on items that are unprocessed Florida agricultural products. In addition, Florida agricultural products in the following categories must meet the specified criteria in order to use the "Fresh From Florida" Identifier.
- (a) Meats/Proteins: the agricultural product must be derived from animals born, raised and finished in Florida. Slaughter and processing must take place in a USDA inspected facility in Florida or within 21 days of exiting the state of Florida en route directly to a USDA inspected slaughter facility, and must comply with USDA labeling guidelines.
- (b) Agritourism activities: The "Fresh From Florida" Identifier is eligible to be used in the promotion of agritourism activities within the state of Florida.
- (c) Seafood: The "Fresh From Florida" Identifier is eligible for use on all Florida seafood products or in the promotion of such products. Seafood products must be landed, grown or harvested in Florida and shall not have been combined with a non-Florida agricultural product.
